Now Read Matthew 26:31-35 & 69-75. This is the same Peter that Jesus calls a "rock". How can we fall short of our identity at work, home, or with friends?

2) Read John 21:15-19. Jesus didn't allow Peter's failure or performance determine his identity. Jesus forgives Peter and brings him back into a right relationship with Jesus. How have you seen or felt Jesus do this in your life or in someone else's life?
