PRACTICAL APPLICATION | Walking It Out

Simon Peter's first step to becoming free was to surrender to Jesus, the One who was truly in control. However, just a couple years later we will see Peter denying that he even knows Jesus. As Jesus was going through his trials to be killed, Peter denies that he knows Jesus. Forsaking all that he had surrendered to Jesus, he walks away. Read through John 21:1-7. After Jesus' resurrection, he appears to Peter in the very same way He did in Luke 5 – Jesus instructs Peter to fish on the other side of the boat. In this act, Jesus forgives Peter and brings him back into a right relationship.

There may be areas of your life where you have failed Jesus. Maybe you've never surrendered that part of your life to Him or maybe you did once, but you took it back like Peter. Just like Peter, Jesus is calling to us again today. Take the Challenge: Whatever it is that you are still holding on to, surrender that to Jesus right now. Let's end our time with a moment for each of us to pray silently and surrender to Jesus.
